Product Name: Ready-Strip Safer Paint Remover

USE AND SAFETY INFORMATION

Ready-Strip Spray is not to be used on sheetrock, plastic, rubber or linoleum surfaces.

DO A TEST AREA FIRST TO DETERMINE RESULTS. SHAKE BOTTLE BEFORE USE.

Directions: Mask any areas not being stripped with plastic and masking tape. Apply at temperatures between 60° and 80° F. Apply Ready-Strip-Spray liberally to the surface. On vertical surfaces, apply as heavily as possible. Depending upon the type and amount of paint, the remover can work in as little as 30 minutes, or stay wet and active for up to 4 hours or more. Periodically test scrape a small area to determine if the paint or varnish is ready to be removed. Use a stiff putty knife to lift paint from flat surfaces or a stiff bristle brush for detailed areas. After initial lifting, use a nylon brush or stripping pad with After-Strip Paint Remover Wash or light amounts of water for final clean-up of residue. Clean up with water. Surface should be dry before repainting.
