USE AND SAFETY INFORMATION

Safety Note: Lacquers and epoxies give off flammable vapors during drying. Always follow the coating manufacturer's directions and warnings, and be aware of the increased fire hazard when coating larger areas. If ventilation equipment is used, it must be explosion proof. If lacquer thinner is used for any other purpose, limit flammable vapors by using only a few ounces at a time. Wait until all vapors are gone between uses. Read all cautions on this label prior to using.

Directions: Never fill an appliance that is still hot from use. Do not open can near sparks, open flame or any other source of heat. Handle with the same care as gasoline. Fill appliance fuel tank according to manufacturer's directions, use a funnel and take care to avoid spilling fuel. Wipe off any excess fuel and close fuel can and appliance fuel tank before igniting. Always fill and use appliances outdoors. Never fill or use appliances inside house, camper, tent or other enclosed area.

- Do not use as a solvent for cleaning or degreasing.
- Do not use in Kerosene, Alcohol or oil burning stoves/lamps.
- Do not use as a fire starter or log igniter.

CAUTIONS: CONTAINS PETROLEUM DISTILLATE. Keep away from heat, sparks and flame. Vapors may ignite explosively. This fuel can cause flash fires and serious burns if used improperly. Contents may be under pressure – open with care. Fuel vapors are invisible, explosive, heavier than air and can be ignited by ignition sources long distances away. DO NOT smoke. Extinguish all flames and pilot lights, and turn off stoves, heaters, water heaters, electric motors and devices, and any other sources of ignition during use and until all vapors are gone. Do not transfer to unlabeled containers. Close container after each use. For disposal guidance of unused product, contact a household hazardous waste program, or your local or state government environmental control agency. Do not re-use can when empty.

Attention: Do not attempt to start or re-ignite charcoal, wood or any other fire with this product. An explosive fire may result or fire may flash back into the can and explode.

Health Hazards: Vapor harmful. May affect the brain or nervous system causing dizziness, headache or nausea. Causes eye, skin, nose and throat irritation. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. If you experience eye watering, headaches, dizziness or have difficulty breathing, increase fresh air or wear respiratory protection (NIOSH approved) or leave the area to obtain fresh air. Reports have associated repeated and prolonged occupational overexposure to solvents with permanent brain and nervous system damage. Intentional misuse by deliberately concentrating and inhaling contents may be harmful or fatal.
